Guidelines and Style

- All categories of contributions should be composed using MS Word 97-2007. A hard copy (A4 size) should be sent along with the CD/DVD and a soft copy should be sent to the email address mentioned above.
- Special articles should contain an abstract of about 100 words summing up the main arguments.
 No endnote references should be included in the abstract.
- All categories of contributions should by accompanied by a signed declaration of originality and conformance to research ethics; also, that the article has not been sent to any other journal for publication and a brief resume of the author in about 50 words.
- Acknowledgements, if any, may be included at the end of the article and before the Notes begin.
- British spelling should be used.

- Notes and References should be numbered in sequential order at the end of the article. Authors are responsible for the accuracy of the references.
