#### Dspace:

DSpace is popular software to develop Digital Libraries and setup Institutional Repositories (IR). This IR helps to upload, index and retrieve various forms of digital content - in text, video, audio, and data. It indexes your work, so that end users can search and retrieve digital items over network. It preserves your digital work over long term. Dspace provides a way to manage your research materials and publications in a professionally maintained repository to give them greater visibility and accessibility over time. #### Who should attend?

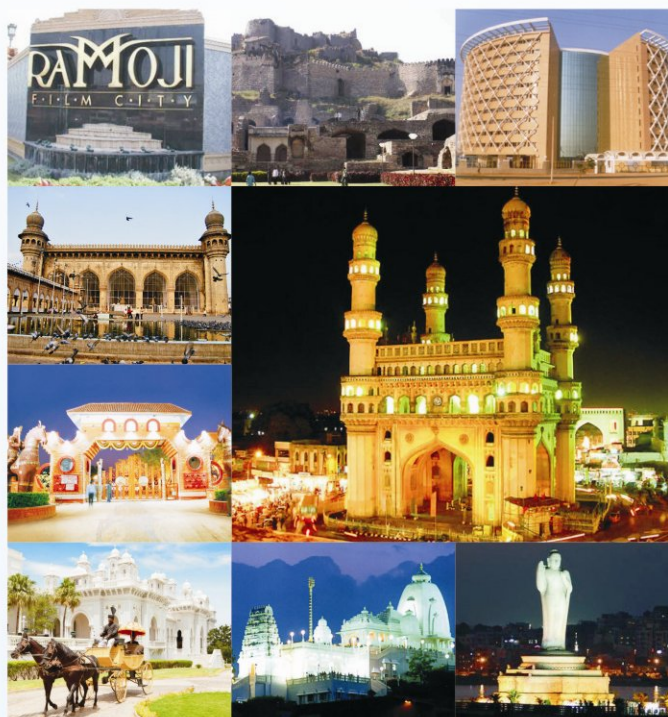
