Under the centrally sponsored scheme, to strengthen and reorganize teacher education, a number of teacher education institutions were upgraded to CTE, and a few into IASE centers of excellence, research and innovations. Accordingly the University college of Education, Osmania University was upgraded to the status of IASE during the year 1996-97. In 2018 it is again renamed as University College of Education. Centre for In-service Teacher Education, Department of Lifelong Learning are also located in the same campus.
