Themes of the Workshop

The focus of this session would be on the identification of research problem with clarity.

Session II: Collection and Analysis of Data

Data analysis offers benefits such as structuring the findings from survey research or other means of data collection, break a macro picture into a micro one, acquiring meaningful insights from the dataset, basing critical decisions from the findings and ruling out human bias through proper statistical treatment. Thus, data analysis is not a decision making system, but decision supporting system. This session would throw light on importance of collection of data and various data analysis tools.

Session III: Report Writing

Writing of report is the last step in a research study and requires a set of skills. This task should be accomplished by the researcher with utmost care. Research task remains incomplete till the report has been presented and/or written. As a matter of fact even the most brilliant hypothesis, highly well designed and conducted research study, and the most striking generalizations and findings are of little value, unless they are effectively communicated to others. The core of this session is on the format, length, style and organisation of a report to present the research results.
