Dr. C. Srinivasulu, heads the Wildlife Biology and Taxonomy Lab and is the curator of the Natural History Museum of Department of Zoology, Osmania University. His field of expertise is wildlife biology and taxonomy. His doctoral and post doctoral research was funded by CSIR. After serving briefly in University of Delhi, he joined the University service in 2007. He served as Public & Relation Officer and Coordinator IQAC, OU, and presently holds the position of the Incharge Director, Osmania Technology Business Incubator; Director Centre for Biodiversity and Conservation Studies, Osmania University; and Director, Gardens & Green Belt, Osmania University. He has to his credit >150 peer-reviewed papers with impact factors ranging from 0.90 – 37.20 with a major publication in SCIENCE (Impact factor: 37.20) and >150 online resources. He is a trained IUCN database modeler, and has contributed to the IUCN Red Listing process of global amphibian, global reptile and global mammal species. He has to his credit 12 books of which his recent book, 'Birds of the Indian Subcontinent – Their Scientific Names Explained', was published in 2022. He is a member of Viper Specialist Group (VSG-IUCN, SSC), and Bat Specialist Group (BSG-IUCN, SSC). He is an elected fellow of Linnean Society of London and Zoological Society of London. Ten research scholars have been awarded Ph.D. degrees and one research scholar is pursuing doctoral research under his guidance. He has executed four major and one minor research project funded by DST, SERB, DBT, UGC and TSBB, and is currently executing DST-SERB and Bat Conservation International funded research projects.
