Sub: **UNIVERSITY TEACHERS** – UGC RSP-2010/2016 – Career Advancement Scheme – Applications called for Exercising option for UGC 3rd Amendment – UGC Regulations-2018 – Circular – Issued.

The University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi through its notification under 4th cited issued, “the Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and other Measures for the Maintenance of Standard in Higher Education) (3rd Amendment) Regulations, 2023,”and the same is adopted in toto by the University vide University Circular 5th cited.

The Rule 6.3 is amended as under:

Regulation	Existing Provision	Amended provision
6.3	The criteria for promotions under Career Advancement Scheme laid down under these Regulations shall be effective from the date of notification of these Regulations. However, to avoid hardship to those faculty members who have already qualified or are likely to qualify shortly under the existing regulations, a choice may be given to them, for being considered for promotions under the existing Regulations. This option can be exercised only within three years from the date of notification of these Regulations.	The criteria for promotions under Career Advancement Scheme laid down under these Regulations shall be effective from the date of notification of these Regulations. <u>However, to avoid hardship to those faculty members who have already qualified or are likely to qualify within six months (till 17th January, 2019)</u> as per the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic staff in Universities and Colleges and other Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2010, a choice may be given to them either, for being considered for promotions under the 2010 or 2018 Regulations. <u>This option can be exercised only up to 31st December 2023 and the date of eligibility shall be retained as the date of promotion.</u> On the date of submission of the application, the candidate should fulfill all eligibility criteria required for promotion.

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In view of the amended provision of Rule 6.3 as mentioned above, applications in the prescribed proforma (in duplicate) are invited from the internal eligible teachers who fulfill the eligibility conditions as on **17.01.2019** as per CAS Regulations of UGC RSP-2016 or UGC RSP-2006 for movement to next higher levels, which are as under:

- i) Assistant Professor Academic Level – 11, Pay Band of Rs.68,900 – 2,05,500/-
(Assistant Professor Rs.15,600-39,100+AGP Rs.7,000/-)
- ii) Assistant Professor Academic Level – 12, Pay Band of Rs.79,800 – 2,11,500/-
(Assistant Professor Rs.15,600-39,100+AGP Rs.8,000/-)
- iii) Associate Professor with Academic Level – 13A, Pay Band of Rs.1,31,400 - 2,17,100/- (Associate Professor Rs.37,400-67,000+AGP Rs.9,000/-)
- iv) Professor with Academic Level – 14, Pay Band of Rs.1,44,200 - 2,18,200/-
(Professor Rs.37,400-67,000+AGP Rs.10,000/-)

The eligible teachers are advised to note the following:

- I. The teachers who will become **eligible** for movement to next higher grade **till 17.01.2019 only needs to apply** either as per UGC RSP-2006 (UGC Regulations-2010) or as per UGC RSP-2016 (UGC Regulations-2018) in view of the above amendment.
- II. The teacher needs to submit option form for upgradation / Promotion **either** as per UGC RSP-2006 (UGC Regulations-2010) **or** as per UGC RSP-2016 (UGC Regulations-2018).
- III. The teacher who have applied for upgradation / promotion under CAS in terms of UGC Regulations 2010, in response to University Circular No. MR-27/58/2022-23/Adm.II-1, dated 19.06.2023, as prior to implementation of UGC 3rd Amendment dated 01.08.2023, can take back the applications along with their Demand Draft from Administration Branch, O.U. and if they feels that, they are fulfilling the criteria in terms of above amendment, **they needs to apply again now.**

Further, the Rule 6.3 VIII is amended as under:

Regulation	Existing Provision	Amended provision
6.3 VIII	The requirement for the Orientation Course and Refresher Course for promotions due under the CAS shall not be mandatory up to 31 st December 2018.	Wherever the requirement of the Orientation Course (OC)/Refresher Course (RC) has remained incomplete, the promotions would not be held up, but these requirements should be fulfilled by 31 st December 2023 or as notified by the Commission from time to time.

In terms of the above amendment, the date of eligibility of the teachers who were upgraded / promoted under CAS of UGC RSP-2006/2016 with effect from the date of completion of OC / RC **shall need to submit an application for modification / restoration of their normal date of eligibility.**

The CAS application of UGC RSP-2006 & 2016, UGC Regulations-2010 & 2018, Option form along with UGC 3rd Amendment can be downloaded from the University website **www.osmania.ac.in** on or after **30.09.2023.**

The filled in application in the prescribed Proforma (in duplicate) and its soft copy through e-mail to **ou_cas@osmania.ac.in** along with a **demand draft of Rs.5,000/-** drawn in favour of the **Registrar, Osmania University**, should reach the undersigned on or before **16.10.2023.**

All the Principals of the University Campus and Constituent Colleges and Heads of Departments are requested to bring it to the notice of all the teachers, of their Colleges / Departments.

Incomplete application and application received after the last date will not be entertained.
