Concept Note:

The Osmania University Centre for International Programmes (OUCIP), Hyderabad, India is organizing a Three Day International Conference on “Major Themes and Concerns in African-American writings : A Reassessment” from **25th – 27th August 2021**. The proposed International Conference will focus on major writings of African–American literature from the world war times to the current generation and how legacy was continued by Post-Second World War novelists such as Saul Below, John Updike, Norman Mailer, J. D. Salinger, Nabokov, Richard Wright, James Baldwin, Ralph Ellison and later by Don DeLillo, Toni Morrison, Robert Stone, Thomas Berger and others.

African- American literature has a unique place and occupying the front position among the world literatures right from the beginning. Social movements of the 1960's caused a spurt in the African-American literature. With such movements as Women's liberation and Civil Rights movement, ethnicity, multiplicity, diversity and hybridity characterized the American psyche under the rubric of liberalism and postmodernism. All this loosened the conservative American society and opened up the closed American mind to other cultures, races and religions both within and outside America. The Jewish American writers added incredible aesthetic vigor and artistic variety to the ethnic American literatures. The growing glory of American literature will go only halfway without the Native American literature. At the same time the Asian American women writers such as Bharathi Mukherjee, Jhumpa Lahiri, Bapsy Sidwa, Shriely Lim, Maxine Hong Kingston, multi-colored canvass of the African-American literature.

In this backdrop, The proposed conference will offer a prominent platform to bring together scholars, academics, experts, writers and critics in the domain of African- American as well as related multi-disciplinary areas to discuss and deliberate on issues and concerns in numerous areas central to the human predicament. Hope the conference will contribute new research topics to the aspiring research scholars as there is greater need to re-examine the major African- American writings from a fresh perspective.
