**About the Speaker:** G.B.Reddy, Professor of Law, Osmania University. Is a lawyer turned academician. He holds a Master's degree in Constitutional Law and Ph.D. on 'Judicial Activism of Supreme Court'. He was the first UGC-JRF in Law from OU. He has special interest in IPRs, published and spoke extensively on the subject. With a combined teaching and research experience of more than 25 years, he authored 24 well received books on Law, 73 papers on law; about 25 edit page articles on socio-legal issues, and successfully guided 14 Ph.D Scholars in Law. He contributes to Indian Law Institute's Annual Survey of Law on Environmental Law. He also offered 4 SWAYAM Courses (MOOCs) on law where in more than 10000 students enrolled. He has been on academic bodies of many prestigious universities like NUALS, NALSAR, MNLU, CUK, HCU and Central University of Karnataka. He delivered more than 400 invited lectured all over India. On administrative side, he worked as the Vice Principal and Principal of University College of Law, Head of Department of Law, and Chairman of BoS in Law, Dean of Faculty of Law of OU and TU, Joint Director and Director of OUFRO, and First Director of OU Legal Cell. He is currently the Director of Prof.G.Ram Reddy Centre for Distance Education of OU. He is also the university's DPIIT-SPRIHA Intellectual Property Rights Chair Professor since 2021.



## **About the Topic: 'Gender Justice- Legal Perspectives'**

Gender is not a biological construct whereas the sex is. In modern times, emphasis has been shifting to gender and gender justice. In view of the principles of gender equality and gender justice imbibed in social, economic and political justice, it is imperative to understand the means of securing gender justice including the legal medium. This public lecture proposes to highlight the constitutional and legal perspectives of gender justice with reference to recent developments in India and other countries. The past experience, present challenges and future goals involving the issues like women empowerment, reforming the existing legal regimes, addressing challenges like sexual harassment of women, and engendering the justice delivery system, are some of the issues identified for analysis. Incidentally, even the issues relating to transgender and their travails also will be highlighted.
