#### ORDERS

Sub:- Osmania University - Allowances - Dearness Allowance - Revision of Rates of Dearness Allowance from 01-07-2014 - Orders - Issued.

Ref:- 1. G.O. Ms. No. 102, Finance (PC-I) Department, Dt.14-05-2014.

2. O.U. Orders No. 2424/261/2014-15/Budget-V, Dt.22-05-2014.

3. G.O. Ms. No.35, Finance (HRM.IV) Department, Dt.01-10-2014.

Through the University orders 2<sup>nd</sup> cited, the Revised Rates of Dearness Allowance with effect from 01-01-2014 have been extended to the Teaching, Non-Teaching and Time-Scale employees of the University (including the Work Charged Establishment), in terms of the G.O, 1<sup>st</sup> cited above.

2. The State Government through the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited, have further Revised the Rates of Dearness Allowance w.e.f. **01-07-2014** to its employees and also extended the benefit to the Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff working in the Universities, drawing pay in A.P. Revised UGC Pay Scales, 1996 & 2006, and A.P. Revised State Pay Scales, 2005 & 2010 and also to those still drawing Pay in A.P. Revised State Pay Scales, 1999 including Work-Charged Establishment, as per the details given below:-

- 3. The Service Associations of both Teaching and Non-Teaching staff of the University have represented for implementation of G.O. (3<sup>rd</sup> cited), for the benefit of University Employees.
- 4. The Vice-Chancellor In-charge, in anticipation of approval of the Finance Committee / Executive Council, has accorded approval for payment of Dearness Allowance to the Teaching, Non-Teaching, Time-Scale and Work-Charged Establishment Employees of the University at the enhanced rates as indicated in para 2, with effect from 01-07-2014.

### 5. The payment will be regulated as follows:-

- i. The arrears of D.A. for the period from **01-07-2014** to **30-09-2014**, shall be credited to G.P.F. Accounts of the respective employees.
- ii. The enhanced rates of D.A shall be included in the salary claims for the month of October 2014, payable on or after 01-11-2014.
- iii. In case of the employees who are due to retire before 31-12-2014, the arrears of Dearness Allowance shall be drawn and paid in cash, as the employee due to retire on superannuation is compulsorily exempted from making any subscription to the GPF accounts during the last four months of service.
- iv. In the event of death of any employee before the issue of these orders, the legal heir(s) shall be entitled to the arrears of enhanced D.A. in cash.
- v. The term 'Pay' for this purpose shall be as defined in F.R. 9 (21) (a) (i).
- 6. The additional expenditure on payment of D.A. at enhanced rates from **01-07-2014** onwards will be charged to the University Fund (Block Grant), in respect of the employees, whose salaries are being paid from the Normal Budget.
- 7. The expenditure in respect of employees whose salaries are being paid from the Schemes financed by the UGC and other agencies will be met out of funds of the respective Schemes. The Dean, Development & UGC Affairs, O.U. will take necessary action to provide funds for this purpose.
- 8. Further, the expenditure in respect of Time-Scale employees, shall be met from the provision from which their salaries are being paid at present.
- 9. These orders are also applicable to the Employees of Work-Charged Establishment who are drawing their pay in Regular Scales of Pay.

- 10. The Deputy Registrar (Pre-Audit), O.U, will admit the claims accordingly.
