For Engineering and Pharmacy courses for the academic year 2023-2024 (For Foreign Students/PIOs (OCIs)/Children of the Indian Workers in Gulf Countries)

Office of the International Affairs (OIA), Osmania University, Hyderabad invites applications from eligible Foreign Students/Overseas Citizen of India (OCIs)/Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs)/Children of the Indian Workers in Gulf Countries (CIWGs) for admission into the following courses for the academic year 2023-2024:

- 1. B.E./ B.TECH. Course at University College of Engineering, Osmania University, University College of Technology, Osmania University.
- 2. B.E./ B.TECH. Course at one Private Affiliated Engineering College under the jurisdiction of Osmania University.
- 3. M.E./ M.TECH. Course at University College of Engineering, Osmania University and University College of Technology, Osmania University.
- 4. B.Pharmacy Course at Private Affiliated Pharmacy Colleges under the jurisdiction of Osmania University and
- 5. M.Pharmacy Course at University College of Technology, Osmania University.

ELIGIBILITY:

S.No.	Course	Eligibility Criteria	
1.	B.E./B.Tech.	The candidate should have secured a minimum of 60% of marks / equivalent grade in the aggregate of Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry at 10+2 level (K12) or an equivalent examination.	
2.	M.E. / M.Tech.	The candidate should have secured a minimum of 60% of marks in the aggregate of all subjects at B.E. / B.Tech. level or an equivalent examination from his / her home country / from India.	
3.	B.Pharmacy	The candidate should have secured a minimum of 60% of marks / equivalent grade in the aggregate of Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry or Biology, Physics, Chemistry at 10+2 level (K12) or an equivalent examination.	
4.	M.Pharmacy	The candidate should have secured a minimum of 60% of marks in the aggregate of all subjects at B.Pharmacy level or an equivalent examination from his / her home country / from India.	



ONLINE ADMISSION PROCESS

The eligible foreign students seeking admission into <u>B.E. / B.TECH. / M.E./ M.TECH./ B.Pharmacy/ M.Pharmacy</u> Programmes can apply through <u>online mode</u> and are required to follow the steps given below:

- i. The following documents are to be scanned and kept ready for uploading on the portal before starting online admission process:
 - a. All stamped pages of Passport of the Candidate.
 - b. The Certificates / Marks sheets of the qualifying examinations as mentioned below:

1.	For B.E. /B.Tech. admissions:	SCANNED COPY OF HIGH SCHOOL/10+2 CERTIFICATES. (10th, 11th and 12th grade certificates)
2.	For M.E. / M.Tech. admissions:	 SCANNED COPY of the Certificate and Marks Sheets of the B.E. / B.TECH. COURSES respectively. SCANNED COPY of the HIGH SCHOOL / 10+2 CERTIFICATE and Marks Sheets
3.	For B.Pharmacy admissions	SCANNED COPY OF HIGH SCHOOL/10+2 CERTIFICATES. (10 th , 11 th and 12 th grade certificates)
4.	For M.Pharmacy admissions	 SCANNED COPY of the Certificate and Marks Sheets of the B.PHARMACY COURSES respectively. SCANNED COPY of the HIGH SCHOOL / 10+2 CERTIFICATE and Marks Sheets

Note: Please enclose the original language version and the translated version of the Certificates and Marks Sheets duly attested by the Ministry of Higher Education/concerned Embassies.

- ii. The candidate has to click on link, 'online admissions' on our website www.oufro.ac.in or www.osmania.ac.in (link foreign students) and register yourself for the desired programme online. (Click on apply for online admissions on our website https://www.oufro.ac.in).
- The candidate has to send the proof of the payment of **Registration-cum-Prospectus fee** to the official mail ID of UFRO, i.e., **director.ufro@gmail.com**, which is mandatory for processing the online applications.

NOTE: The Registration-cum-Prospectus fee mentioned in the Fee Structure for Self-Finance Foreign Students for the academic year 2023-24 has to be remitted through any Payment Gateway / Credit Card / Debit Card / NEFT / any other online transfer in favour of THE DIRECTOR, UFRO, OU, bearing Account Number 52198263092, IFSC CODE: SBIN0020071, Swift Code: SBININBBH09 and MICR No.: 500002342 and enter the Unique Transaction Reference (UTR) in the application. THIS REGISTRATION-CUM-PROCESSING FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE.

- iv. Passport size Photo. (Scanned soft copy)
- v. Signature of the Candidate. (Scanned soft copy)
- vi. No Objection Certificate / Migration Certificate from the last studied Institute / University if pursued in India.
- NOTE: 1. The full name of the candidate is taken from the High School certificate /10+2 certificate. So, the candidate's name on the certificate should match with his/her name in the Passport. This office shall not accept any discrepancies in the name of the candidate.
 - 2. NRIs/ Children of the workers in Gulf Countries seeking admission into B.E. / B.Tech./ B.Pharmacy courses are required to submit the following certificates in addition to the above documents:
 - a. Bonafide/Certificates of study abroad.
 - b. NRI status certificates for the candidate and the parent(s).
 - c. Work permit of the parent(s) (Employment Certificate) working in the Gulf Countries.
 - d. Stamped pages of Passport of the parent(s) working in the Gulf Countries



OFFLINE ADMISSION PROCESS

The eligible foreign students seeking admission into B.E./ B.TECH. / M.E./ M.TECH./ B.Pharmacy/M.Pharmacy programmes through offline mode can do so either by applying online and submitting physically if already in India or through an authorized person on his/her behalf (the authorization letter format can be downloaded from our website www.oufro.ac.in). However, they are required to follow the steps given below:

- Fill in the application online even if there is an authorized person to seek admission on your behalf and affix one passport size photo in the place provided. (Click on apply for online admissions on our website https://www.oufro.ac.in, and submit the print out)
- > Fill all the details in the application form, take a print out of the filled-in application form.
- > Submit the printout of the filled-in application form along with all the required documents.
- Pay the Registration-cum-Prospectus fee through a DEMAND DRAFT drawn in favour of "The Director, UFRO, OU" from any Nationalized Indian Bank, payable at Hyderabad or follow the online payment step mentioned in the online admission process.
- Submit the proof of the online/offline payment along with the filled-in application form which is mandatory for processing the offline applications. <a href="https://example.com/refundable-nample-na

SCANNED COPY of the HIGH SCHOOL/10+2 CERTIFICATE and Marks Sheets (Please enclose the original language version and the translated version of the Certificates and Marks Sheets duly attested by the Ministry of Higher Education/concerned Embassies.) 	

- One Passport size Photo.
- Candidate's signature only.
- No Objection Certificate / Migration Certificate from the last studied Institute /University if pursued in India.
