The knowledge and insights gained through this seminar will play a crucial role in guiding governments towards harnessing the potential of digital technologies while addressing the associated challenges.

Osmania University

Established in 1917, Osmania University is a centre for academic excellence and a shining beacon for higher education. It takes pride in being the third-oldest university in South India and the oldest in the state of Telangana. It was founded by His Exalted Highness Mir Osman Ali Khan, Asaf Jah VII, the Nizam of Hyderabad. Up until the middle of the 1950s, it was the first university to offer higher education in Urdu as the primary language of instruction. Since then, English has been the primary language of instruction.

Osmania University, which has more than 1000 colleges affiliated with it, used to be the largest affiliating university in Asia. Nearly 3.5 lakh students are being served by eight campus, five constituent, five district PG, and 721 affiliated colleges located throughout the districts of Hyderabad, Ranga Reddy, Sangareddy, Medchal-Malkajgiri, Siddipet, and Medak. It received "A+" rating from the NAAC in 2017 for its third cycle of accreditation.

Additionally, the UGC has awarded the University "Category I" status in 2018. According to the National Institutional Ranking Framework for 2022, it is ranked number 22 among universities in India. It has appeared in rankings for "Emerging Economies Universities Ranking", "Top 250 Asian Universities," "QS India Ranking," "QS BRICS Ranking," etc.

With over 68 academic fields and 53 departments dispersed among its colleges, Osmania University is a multi-faculty and multi-locational institution that offers a comprehensive education. Since its founding, the university has grown and has contributed to the creation and sharing of knowledge across all academic areas, including science and technology. In addition to research through PhD, it offers roughly 90 courses at the post graduate level and 34 courses at the undergraduate level (with 125 combinations) 65 different disciplines.

About The Department

The Department of Public Administration was established in 1956 with a two-year PG Diploma course and one-year certificate course for the benefit of under-graduate employees in both public and private organizations. The Department became a full-fledged one with the introduction of Public Administration as an independent subject at the under-graduate level in 1958. It witnessed further expansion in 1961 when Master's programme was offered on a regular basis. The basic aim of introducing the M.A. becourse was to enable students to take up careers in government service and public affairs. The research activity got a fillip with the introduction of doctoral programme in 1964 and M.Litt, (now called M.Phil.), in 1970. A number of faculty members and officers of the government registered themselves for research work. Public Administration was introduced at the Plus Two level (Intermediate) in Andhra Pradesh in 1980-81 in selected colleges. From then on, Public Administration is being taught at all the levels of collegiate education in the state.

In 1984, the Department started a two-year PG Diploma in Public Personnel Management (PPM) for in-service executives. Subsequently, the course was converted into two-year Master's Degree. It was formulated to meet the needs of management education and inculcate professionalism in civil service. Presently, the Department is offering Master's courses at three Post-Graduate centers, and Masters programmes in Public Personnel Management for the Distance Education Students. The total number of students at Master's level is around 120 and the number in under graduate level in 125 affiliated colleges is approximately 9000. With the introduction of Public Administration as one of the subjects both in civil services examination of the UPSC TSPSC and APPSC, the Department has gained immense popularity among the student community.

Sponsored by the Central and State governments the Department conducted several Management Development Programmes to civil servants including officers of all -India and central services as well as state and local government officials. These courses were called Management in Government, Executive Development, Personnel Management, etc. In 1967, the Urban Administration Centre was established in the Department to cater to the research and training needs of Municipal Administration. 1970, the centre's area of activities spread to cover the other southern states. Hence the nomenclature was changed to Regional Centre for Urban & Environmental Studies. Over the years, the centre has diversified into training, research, consultancy, extension education and collaborative programmes.

The Department has an excellent faculty with exposure to public administration at the national and international levels. The basic objective of the faculty is to constantly re-invent itself in tune with the changing as well as future needs of economy and society so as to impart skills, knowledge and leadership among the students. The other objective is to promote research efforts of academic staff to better understanding of the nature, problems, and potential of modern society in the realm of governance and administration.
