Selection:

An Expert Committee Headed by the Dean, Faculty of Law, Osmania University the application according to the following criteria.

i)Papers Published:

1. Only the papers published as Corresponding Author.
2. Cumulative Impact Factor (IF) of any Reputed Journal (Scopus / UGC Care – II/ ABDC Journal / Thomason Reuters in which the papers are published during the Assessment Period (1st December 2020 to 31st December 2021) is multiplied with 5 marks.



ii) Papers Presented:

1. National Level: 2 marks / Presentation
2. International Level: 5 marks / Presentation
